Searching Databases

[WorldCat Local](#), for books/ebooks, video/streaming video, journal articles, *use to request Interlibrary Loan*. Search **Libraries Worldwide** when you need to request an Interlibrary Loan. Also, good if you have a citation otherwise and do not know what database to search to find the article.

[EBSCOhost](#), for journal articles (including peer-reviewed articles); search [CINAHL](#)

[PubMed](#), for peer reviewed research articles, clinical trials. For access to Cedar Crest Cressman Library subscriptions, use the [PubMed LinkOut with CCC holdings](#) link from the Nutrition LibGuide and look for the Cedar Crest logo in the upper right corner of the abstract page.

Limit to just CCC holdings with: `loprovpacccclib[filter]`. Here is a sample search: [macronutrients AND loprovpacccclib\[filter\]](#)

Use the `loprovpacccclib` filter in combination with [PubMed LinkOut](#) so that our Cedar Crest logo appears when we have access to an article.

NOTICE: The LinkOut with CCC holdings link will persist throughout your session even if, afterward, you open another tab and use the [PubMed](#) link instead of the LinkOut one. The LinkOut with CCC holdings does, however, time-out after 8 hours.

[SAGE](#), for peer reviewed journal articles. See list of Cressman Library Nutrition journals at SAGE, p. 6.

[ScienceDirect](#), for peer reviewed journal articles. Go to advanced search and limit to Nursing and Health Professions. Or, stay on the journals landing page. Filter by subject: Health Sciences, then click just the + Nursing and Health Professions and from there just Nutrition. Click APPLY to see the list of Nutrition journals that we have access to. Look for the completely green or orange squares.



[Google Scholar](#), for journal articles. Like searching for articles in WorldCat Local with Libraries Worldwide selected, Google Scholar is really good to use if you already have a citation and don't know what database it is in.

[E-Journals & Periodicals](#), for journal titles. Great if you have the name of a journal and need to know whether or not the library has access to it.

Searching for:

macronutrient metabolism

macronutrients metabolism

macronutrients AND metabolism

“macronutrient intake”

“macronutrient interventions”

Add “[nutrition OR diet](#)” and [intervention](#) to the search:

((nutrition OR diet) AND macronutrients and intervention)

nutrition AND intervention AND macronutrients

What to look for in a database:

How does the database sort the results? By most recent? By relevance?

Can the results be narrowed to the last 5 years or another date range?

Is the full text available? Can I limit to just what the library has access to?

What to look for in a journal or journal article:

Is it peer reviewed?



Use the EBSCOhost database cite tool to copy/paste the APA citation for an article. First, go to the detailed record by clicking the article title, then select the cite tool.

Be sure to check that the citations you've copied/pasted from the database cite tools, whether from CINAHL, Google Scholar, or WorldCat Local, etc. fit the examples in the APA Publication Manual. You may need to edit for spacing and indentation, along with other minor changes.

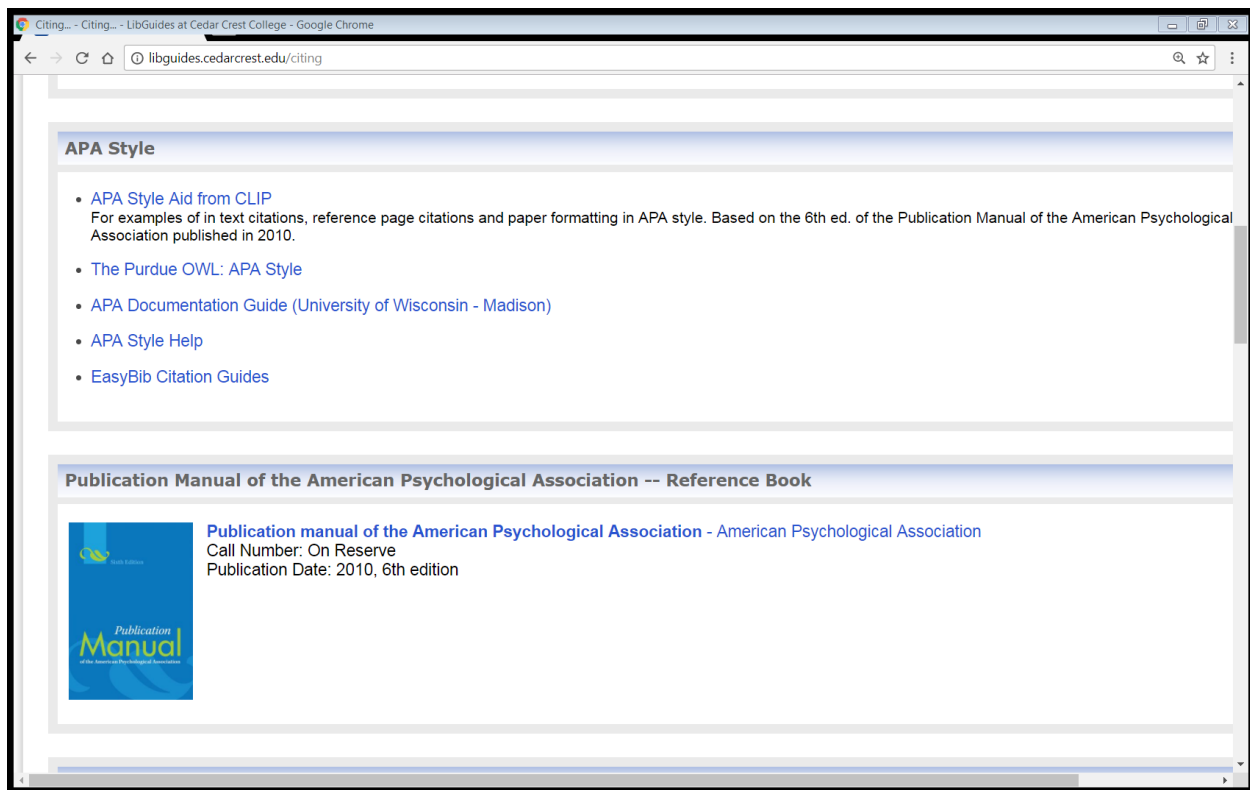
